ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Rangapara College is the fruit of dedicated efforts put in by a group of social workers to establish an institute of higher education to enlighten the people of the area. Rangapara town is an old settlement with a mixed population. The college is situated in a serene ambience encompassing by lush green tea gardens. Mountains of Arunachal Pradesh, its greenery and pleasant climate defines the beauty of the location. The college was accredited B+ grade in 2004 and reaccredited B grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2011 in its second cycle.

HOW TO REACH

The college is located in between the small township of Rangapara and Balipara of Sonitpur District of Assam and is surrounded by several tourist spots like Nameri National Park, Mountains of Arunachal Pradesh and the historic town of Tezpur. The nearest railway station is the Rangapara North, which is at a distance of 5km from the college. The college is located at a distance of nearly 25km. from the District headquarter, Tezpur. One can reach the college by road from Tezpur via Balipara. Buses and tempos are available at a regular interval from both the directions of Balipara and Rangapara to the college. The nearest airport is Salonibari, Tezpur, which is half an hour drive away from the college.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Mahapurush Srimanta Sankardeva is considered as a great saint and social reformer. He was born in 1449, in Nagaon district of Assam. He is widely acknowledged for his philosophies which shaped the socio-cultural structure of Assam. He is the pioneer of the new form of music-the Borgeet, drama—the AnkiaNaat, the Satriya dance and the Brajavali literary language. Srimanta Sankardev did spread the tenets of Vaishnavism and played an important role in social unification irrespective of the caste, creed and religion. This national level seminar is an attempt to assimilate his ideas and to have scholarly discussion on the role played by his generous ideology in social integration.

Abstract Submission

Moreover, it is requested to follow the ordering- Title of the paper, Name of the author/co-authors, designation, institution and email Id. The abstract must be sent either in English or Assamese.

Full Paper Submission

The full paper should be written in MS Word Format within 3000 words including works cited and must be submitted within the specified date mentioned below. The full paper must be submitted on the day of seminar. The E-mail for sending the full paper is stated below. The font should be of **Times New Roman** in **12 sizes** with **double line spacing**. The text of the paper must be justified with a **margin of 1 inch** from all around. Full paper may be submitted in **English**, **Assamese**, **Bengali**, **Bodo**, **Hindi and Nepali**.
