Established in the year 1979, Rangapara College was affiliated to Gauhati University in the year 1980. The college was brought under deficit grant-in-aid system from 01/01/1987 was included under Section 12 (B) of UGC Act from 20/03/1996. In the year 2004, the college was accredited 'B+' by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), and college was re-accredited 'B' grade in 2011. Beginning its humble origin from Rangapara Town Hall, it was shifted to the present sprawling campus of 41 acres (122 bighas) amidst lush green tea gardens on 16th August, 1979. Since its inception, the expansion of the college has been phenomenal. The faculty strength has increased manifold; thereby producing more and more students over the past few years. ADMISSION REQUIREMENT : FOR T.D.C. COURSES

A student who has the following eligibility may get admission into the Three Year Degree Course.

- (i) Passed Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Arts / Science / commerce from Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, Central Board of Secondary Education or any other Examination conducted by a Board / organisation recognised by Government
- (ii) A student of an affiliated college of Gauhati University may get himself/herself admitted into the same class on production of transfer certificate along with conduct certificate and attendance record.
- (iii) No graduate of Gauhati University or any other University shall get admission in to the Three Years Degree courses again.
- (iv) Rules and regulations framed in connection with admission by Gauhati University from time to time will strictly be applicable for admission.
- (v) Admission will be strictly on merit basis and reservation of seats will be done as per Govt. rules.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

1. The academic work in each semester will require the student to engage with chosen courses the content of which will be described in detail in the syllabi.
2. Each course will have credits, assigned on the basis of course related activities, which a student will earn through satisfactory fulfilment of the academic requirement of the course.
3. A. An undergraduate degree programme with honours in a discipline will have a course credit requirement of 148 credits.
B. An undergraduate degree programme without honours will require a student to earn 132 course credits.
C. Students in an honours programme can opt to earn additional credits by undertaking elective courses subject to the condition that the total number of course credit does not exceed 160 credits.
4. The medium of instruction and examination will be English or Assamese, except in language courses.
5. The courses are categorised as core courses, elective courses or ability enhancement courses.

INSTRUCTION FOR ADMISSION

Students seeking new admission for the session 2019-20 should first register by the college admin at the time of buying Prospectus. (College admin shall fill-up all the mandatory fields like Candidate Name, Father's name, Email Id, Mobile Number, Class, Stream, Semester, Course in the registration part).

After successful registration, student will get an SMS on their particular mobile number and also get an Email having USER-ID & PASSWORD for completion of online application.

Please note: The MOBILE NO & EMAIL ID used for registration must belong to the applicant. The MOBILE NO & EMAIL ID must be valid and functional. There is no scope for changing the registered email address in future. All communications shall be sent only to the registered email address.

Step 2: By using that particular USER-ID & PASSWORD (Which will be provided by the college admin at the time of selling prospectus), the student can get their Online Application form .

o Passport size photograph (Mandatory) –Format JPEG/JPG - below 50 KB

o Image Dimension of photograph should be 3.5 cm(width) * 4.5 cm(Height) only

o Signature (Mandatory) –Format JPEG/JPG - below 50 KB

o Image Dimension of signature should be 3.5 cm(length) * 1.5 cm(Height) only

o Income certificate (Mandatory for BPL students) –Format JPEG/JPG - below 50 KB

Step 3: The student will have to fill up all the mandatory fields like DOB, Nationality, Name of the school last attended, Address, Previous Examination details, Subject intended to study, Migration, Declaration etc. correctly . Before submitting that particular Application, the student must verify all data whether it was correct or not. Then Click on **SUBMIT** button.

Step 4: After successful submission of the application form, the student can download their filled Application Form, Bank Challan Copy and Declaration copy in pdf format.

B. General Reservation Rules for HS and BA/B.Com/Honours/Regular Classes

- a. There is a provision for reservation of seat, as per Govt. Of Assam rules (OBC/MOBC-15%, SC-7%, ST(P)-10% ST(H)-5%, Sports-1%, NCC/NSS-1%, Culture-1%. For all candidates belonging to the state of Assam and in this respect caste certificate issued by the competent authority under Govt. of Assam only be valid. There is a provision of reservation of 3% of the total seats for 'Differently Abled' candidates.
- b. I) Seat may be allotted in HS & BA / B.Com Courses to the students having outstanding performance in the field of Sports, Culture, NCC and Scouts & Guides.
- (ii) Outstanding sports person / cultural activist who represented the State / University / Country in inter-university / National / International meet will be admitted directly without considering the cut off mark. However the maximum number of seats in a particular class will not enhanced for inclusion of such candidates.
- (iii) Sport persons will be selected from those disciplines which are recognized by AOC/IOC and BCCI and also such sports which are included in All India University meets.
- (iv) In case of Culture quota, candidates will be selected for their proficiency in the field of Music (Vocal), Drama, Debating and Quiz, Fine Arts and Sculpture. In case of music (instrumental) and Dance, Candidates will have to produce degree / diploma certificates from recognized institution.
- However, if candidates, selected under above mentioned quota, do not participate in the respective events/activities on behalf of Rangapara College, they may forfeit their seats. They will have to give written undertakings in this regard.

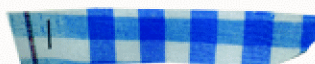
: College Uniform :

College uniform is compulsory for all students. Students without proper uniform will not be allowed entry into the college premises. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ❖ **Identity Card** : Every bonafide student will be issued college identity card at the time of admission which must be renewed in the beginning of every academic session. Entry to the college will not be allowed without I Card.
- ❖ **General Rules** : Students admitted to the college must follow the rules and regulations of the college strictly. Irregular attendance, violation of rules, misconduct in any form, adopting unfair means at the examination, smoking and consuming liquor and drugs will be treated as serious offences leading to suspension or even expulsion from the college.
- ❖ **Ragging is strictly prohibited** : Student found indulging in Ragging in any form will be expelled from the college.
- ❖ **Organizations, societies etc.** : Organizations, Societies etc. of the students of Rangapara college, will function only under the guidance of the college authority. Only the organisations /societies recognized by the college authority will be permitted to use the facilities of the college premises. All the notices desired to be pasted or circulated must be countersigned by the principal.
- ❖ Students failing to attend classes for 15 (fifteen) days at a stretch in the first month of commencement of classes shall forfeit their seats.
- ❖ Mobile phone must be switched off in the plinth area of the college.
Before filling up of the forms of final examination student must produce the following document-
 - i) Clearance certificate from the college office.
 - ii) Clearance certificate from the Librarian.
 - iii) Clearance certificate from the Superintendent of the hostel in case of hostel boarder.
 - iv) Clearance certificate from the HOD of the Department Concerned in case of Major student at BA/B.Com level .
 - v) Attendance percentage from the HOD of the concerned subject.

ATTENDANCE RULES

Student who do not attend at least 75% of the classes will not be allowed to appear in any examinations conducted by concern authorities.

Student who fails to attend their classes for a certain period at a stretch on genuine and acceptable grounds such as serious diseases or accidents and related treatment involving the students themselves and the members of the family, death or near and dear ones, academic / sports / cultural activities approved by the college and effected by nature calamities must apply to the HOD concerned for consideration of leave of absence for the period immediately after such absence. Application must be supported with testimonials/documents and should be countersigned by Guardian / Parents. Even for such cases the actual attendance must not be less than 50%.

The following criterion will be adopted for awarding marks from attendance as per G.U. CBCS regulation -

- a) Class attendance from 91% and above - 4 marks
- b) Class attendance from 86% to 90% - 3 marks
- c) Class attendance from 81% to 85% - 2 marks
- d) Class attendance from 75% to 80% - 1 mark
- e) Class attendance below 75% - 0 mark

2. Download the prospectus from the link given at the top of the page and ensure that you have gone through it thoroughly before filling up the form. Please ensure that you fulfill the eligibility criteria before filling the form. Details of selection process can be found in the prospectus.
3. Form once submitted cannot be edited further.
4. The Student can buy the Prospectus by paying Rs. 150/- cash from the cash counter of the college.
5. Fill the online form paying **Rs 150/- as application fee**. Candidate has to follow bill desk payment gateway for payment using internet banking/ Debit Card/ Credit Card within the stipulated time period. The fee is non refundable.
6. Submit printed application form along with self attested document to the college office during office hours.
7. Merit list will be notified in the college website on the specified date.
8. Admission will be strictly on merit basis as per guidelines detailed in the prospectus.
9. Reservation of seats shall be as per government norms.

College Library :

The College has a spacious library comprising an area of 3000 sq feet with a sitting capacity of 50 readers. The library has a good collection of 27,049 text, reference and other books with 19 no of journals and magazine, 11 news papers in English, Assamese, Hindi, Bengali and Bodo. The Library remains open from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in all working days except on Saturdays. On Saturday it remains open from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

A Student is not allowed to keep books for more than 15 days from the date of issue. In case a student fails to return the books within the stipulated period, he/she will be penalized. Books lost, defaced or mutilated in any way shall have to be replaced by the concerned borrower.

The library is being modernised and the process of library automation has been completed. The library provides Xerox facilities and book-bank facilities. As part of upgradation, digital infrastructure is going to be set up with the financial help of the state Government.

The library is equipped with CC Camera for surveillance. Internet facilities for students and N list facilities from INFLIBNET Ahmedabad are also available in the library.

- i) To be eligible for admission into 1st year class of Higher Secondary, a student has to pass H.S.L.C. Examination of SEBA or any other equivalent examination recognised by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council.
- ii) There will be 300 seats in H.S. 1st year Arts and 150 seat for H.S. 1st year Commerce.
- iii) For issuing of forms, minimum 40% marks will be required in H.S.L.C. or other equivalent examination.

Students promoted to H.S. 2nd year classes on the basis of the H.S. 1st year result declared by the college shall have to deposit college fees within two weeks of declaration of result - the exact dates will be notified by the principal.

The unsuccessful students of H.S. 1st year Examination of AHSEC can take admission as casual students just after the completion of regular H.S. 1st year admission.

The unsuccessful students of H.S. Final Examination of AHSEC appearing from the college shall enroll their names as casual students of H.S. 2nd year class respectively as notified by the college authority.

HOSTEL

BOYS' & GIRLS' HOSTEL (FEES & RULES)

The college will provide hostel seats to a limited number of students. Allocation of hostel seats will be made strictly on merit basis. In exceptional cases the distance of the residence of the student to college may be considered. The fees structure for hostel admission will be -

1. Admission: Rs. 1000/-
2. Security: Rs. 500/- (Refundable)
3. Seat Rent: Rs. 4950/-
4. Medical: Rs. 50/-
5. Electricity Bill: Rs. 1000/- (Yearly)

Total: Rs. 7500

All students must pay Rs. 7500/- at the time of Hostel Admission.

- i. The admitted students are to report to the superintendent before boarding for the first time.
- ii. The boarders must maintain a decent, dignified and disciplined hostel life style inside and outside the hostel.
- iii. They must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel as may be prescribed to them by the college authority, violation of which will invite strict disciplinary action amounting to expulsion from the college.
- iv. Boarders must enter into the hostel within the time fixed by the superintendent / warden and must be present at their respective seats at the time of evening prayer and roll call.
- v. Visitors other than legal/local guardians are allowed to meet the inmates of the hostel without the permission of the principal/Superintendent.
- vi. Boarder must have to pay their mess-dues as may be fixed from month to month by the mess-committee within the 10th days of every month.
- vii. Ill-treatment to co-boarders, cooks and other employees of the hostel will be considered as an offence.
- viii. The use of electrical equipments such as iron, heater etc. is not permitted.
- ix. The boarders must attend their classes regularly and must appear in all internal examination and other academic activities or the departments of the college.
- x. Disturbance of any kind during study hours is treated as serious offence.
- xi. All boarders must abide by the hostel/mess rules prescribed by the college authority and mess-committee respectively.
- xii. **Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and is legally punishable under the rule.**
- xiii. The boarders are to report the superintendent in writing of his permission while leaving the hostel.
- xiv. Boarder are allowed to leave the hostel for various purposes only for a day in the week fixed by the superintendent.
- xv. The students leaving for private tuition/coaching classes are to maintain a register showing the signature of their respective tutor/teacher.
- xvi. Visiting hours : Summer - 3:00p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Winter - 2:30p.m. to 4:00p.m.
- xvii. **Boarders are not allowed to use mobile phone after evening prayer till 9:00a.m. next day.**
