Conditions for Fee waiver

- 1. The fee waiver scheme is available only for the students whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 2.00 Lakh
- 2. If either of the parent of a student is working in Government, such students shall not be eligible under the scheme.
- 3. Students seeking admission under the fee waiver category will require to plant a sapling at the college or his/her home and growth of the same will be verified to allow free admission in the subsequent years.
- 4. The scheme is applicable only to the regular students.
- 5. For Fee waiver following documents will be accepted
 - a) Income Certificate from The Circle Officer.
 - b) Income Certificate from the Head of the Institute from where the students has passes out
 - c) A Notary/Affidavit in respect of Annual income of the parents.

The income certificate submitted by the students will be verified by the competent authority within one year and action as per Law will be taken against anyone where submission of false certificate is established.
