




REPORT

1. Objectives:

- To bring a consciousness among students to write correct spellings

- 2. Target Group: Students
- Significance of the Event: Spelling Bee improves the vocabulary of students. The competitive spirit facilitates in learning new words with correct spelling and pronunciation.
- 4. Description of the Programme: The event commenced at 11 A.M. with coordinator, Mr. Niku Chetia introducing the esteemed guests- Dr. Ranjan Kalita (Principal of Rangapara College), Dr. Ranendra Mohan Deka (Vice-Principal of Rangapara College) and Dr. Aswini Kumar Deka (Assistant Professor, Department of Assamese). 


