Environmental Studies

In the subject of Environmental studies tours are organized with the students to explore the environmental concerns and also students need to prepare reports of the field visit. Followings are the details of the environmental study tours

1. Ecosystem and Wildlife Conservation at Pakke tiger Reserve, Sejusa, Sonitpur, Assam
Date: 12.10.2018. The Visit was conducted to give exposure to the area and also the measures taken to conserve the wild animals.
2. Awareness Programme on Man-Animal Conflict at Sonai Rupai Wild Life Sanctuary, Sonitpur, Assam. Date: 28-04-2019. The visit was conducted to create awareness on the man animal conflict specially man-elephant conflict. The visit also emphasized the measures and the precautions to be followed to mitigate the conflict.
3. Soil erosion and Industrial effects on the environment and Jia Bharali River: A case study at Balijan, Sonitpur, Assam. Date: 21-04-2017. The visit was organized as the Jia Bharali River is the prominent river in Sonitpur District which contribute significantly in the agriculture sector of the district. In the visit the human interference in contaminating the river was explored by the students and they were asked to provide suggestion to reduce the river pollution to ensure a sustainable environment.
4. Eco System and Conservation of Wild Life at Nameri national Park: A case study, Sonitpur, Assam. Date: 14-11-2017
The Visit was organized to make the students aware about the eco system of the Nameri National Park and the human interference in the buffer zone of the national park and along with that the visit also highlighted challenges faced to conserve the wild animals with the help of the forest personnel.
5. Eco System and Conservation of Bio Diversity at Singri, Dhekijuli, Sonitpur, Assam. Date 19-04-2018
The visit was organized to highlight the significance of the bio diversity conservation for the sustainable development. Moreover, the visit also emphasized the impact of human habitant on the Brahmaputra River.

Field Study of Department of History

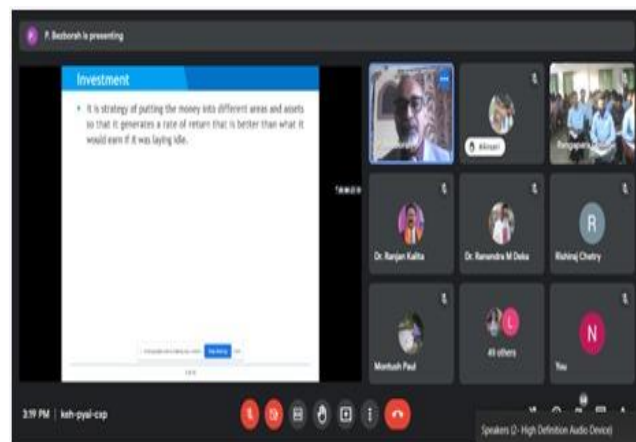
In this the students are taken to a place of tourism interest in the North East India for exploring the prospects of tourism under the supervision of the departmental teachers and accordingly they need to submit a report
