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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON FEEDBACK

The authority has thoroughly scrutinized feedback responses given by the students and adopted stringent measures instantaneously to solve their issues. The upgradation of classrooms into Information and Communication Technology (ICT) classrooms by installing projectors has been ensured by the authority. The teachers have been encouraged to use Google Classroom as an online teaching and evaluation platform. The authority has also dedicated a Digital Classroom on the first floor of the Commerce Block for students. Along with that, a new Digital Seminar Hall was inaugurated in order to organize seminars and various academic programmes for the students. A decision was taken by the authority to construct additional classrooms to accommodate the increasing number of students. In case of syllabus completion, the authority has been monitoring progress through feedback forms. Students have also been provided with a Grievance Redressal link on the college website by the authority. The authority has directed the teachers to ensure the timely completion of the syllabus. They have also been asked to conduct regular tests, seminars and group discussions in order to accelerate academic growth amongst students.

In order to ensure better communication between authority and faculty members, meetings (online and offline) are held frequently. In these platforms, teachers are allowed to put forward their opinions and suggestions. To facilitate research, the authority has also introduced projects which are sponsored by the college. With regard to the feedback received from alumni, the authorities have also been conducting meetings with alumni frequently to strengthen the role and facilitate contribution towards the college. In order to accelerate the participation of Rangapara and Balipara's leading citizens, authorities have invited them to participate in various activities of the college. Cultural activities have been done by conducting *naam* in the college during Shrimanta Shankardev tithis with the active participation of Rangapara's culturally active citizens. With regard to vocational courses, the college has taken steps to set up an Industrial Training Institute (ITI) inside the college campus.


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
